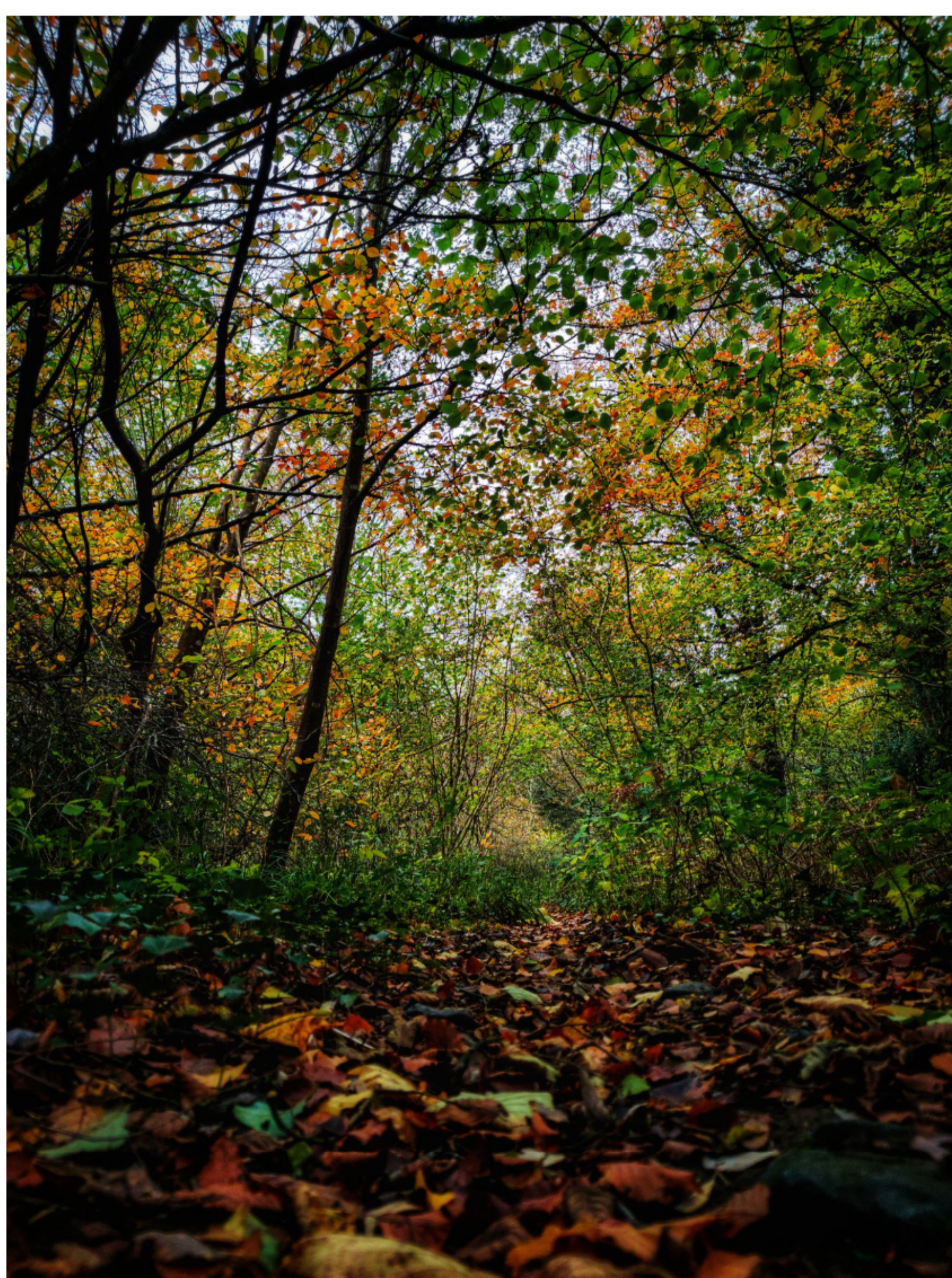

New

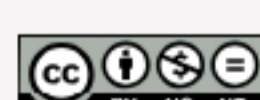
Skin of sycamore,
